1. Participation Requirements

- 1.1 The Sturgeon Bay Boys Fast Break Club(SBBFBC) Program is open to any 4th 8th grade Student who:
 - 1.1.1 Resides in the Sturgeon Bay High School District
 - 1.1.2 Attends a parochial school within the Sturgeon Bay High School District.
- 1.2 All players and parents must read and sign code of conduct, medical consent, concussion, & liability waiver,
- 1.3 For those students who are deemed Special Needs the criteria below will need to be met to participate.
 - 1.3.1 Needs need to be communicated with the coach.
 - 1.3.2 Parents and Coaches(grade level and Varsity level) must meet prior to the start of the season to better to better understand the situation and put a plan in place.

2. Program Expectations

- 2.1 Develop positive relationships with teammates and coaches
- 2.2 Develop positive work ethic and character
- 2.3 Fine tune individual skills and develop each player for the next level
- 2.4 Advance team play in accordance with the high school system
- 2.5 Foster a love and passion for the game
- 2.8 Build sportsmanship and foster brotherhood

3. Practice Schedule

3.1 Teams will practice two to three times per week based on grade level and coach/gym availability.

4. Game Schedule

- 4.1 4th 6th Grade
 - 4.1.1. Season runs (approximately) from Mid November through February exact end date depends on team schedule.
 - 4.1.2. Parents will be expected to sign up for game day duties including admissions, scorekeeping, clock operation.
 - 4.1.3. All costs for games will covered by SBBFBC
 - 4.1.4. Traveling to away games will be the responsibility of the parents.
- 4.2 7th & 8th Grade
 - 4.2.1 Season runs(approximately) from January through February/March

5. League Playing Time

- 5.1 The club policies on specific grade level playing time are intended to be used as a guide. Exact playing time will be determined by the Head Coach for each grade level. SBBFBC will not dictate playing minutes as coaches must be given the flexibility to teach/coach.
- 5.2 Specific questions about playing time should be directed to the Head Coach at your grade level. A 24 hour waiting period, after a game or tournament, should be observed if playing time is to be questioned.
- 5.3 Coaches may reduce a player's playing time for attendance/behavior issues at practice.
- 5.3.1 4th Grade: Playing time will be as close to equal as possible. Every player will have some playing time each half. However, practice attendance, attitude, teamwork, and effort will be considered.
- 5.3.2 5th & 6th Grade: Playing time will not be equal and will be determined by skill, attitude, attendance, teamwork and effort. Each player will have some playing time each half.

5.3.3 7th & 8th Grade: Playing time will not be equal and will be determined by skill, attitude, attendance, teamwork and effort.

6. Tournament Teams

- 6.1 Extra opportunities for play may be available through the formation of tournament teams in Grades 4-8.
- 6.2 Tournament Teams will be limited to approximately 10 players.
- 6.3 Player selection for the tournament teams will be through the evaluation of players at each grade level by the Sturgeon Bay Varsity Coaching Staff, with final approval of the team by the Varsity Head coach.
- 6.4 Playing time will not be equal and will be determined by skill, attitude, attendance, teamwork, and effort. Coaches will coach to compete.
- 6.5 Playing up a level is not allowed unless numbers do not allow a team to be composed(Roster falls below 8 players).
- 6.6 Funding for the additional games/tournament team will be provided by the SBBFBC at the following levels.
 - 6.6.1. 4th Grade up to \$400
 - 6.6.2 5th Grade up to \$400
 - 6.6.3 6th Grade up to \$600
 - 6.6.4 7th Grade up to \$800
 - 6.6.5 8th Grade up to \$1000

7. Coaches

- 7.1 Interested coaches/assistant coaches will:
 - 7.1.2. Complete a background check
 - 7.1.3. 4th 6th Grade
 - 7.1.3.1. The Head Coach and assistants will be interviewed and approved by the Varsity Coach and coaching staff.
 - 7.1.3.2. Assistant coaches will be chosen by their respective grade Head Coach.
 - 7.1.4. 7th 8th Grade
 - 7.1.4.1. The Head Coach and assistants will be interviewed and approved by the Varsity Coach and coaching staff.
- 7.2 Coaches will follow prescribed methods from the Sturgeon Bay Varsity Basketball Coaching Staff as it relates to style of play, fundamentals taught, and practice organization.

- 8.1 All fees for each grade level will be determined by the SBBFBC
- 8.2 Fees are due at the time of registration.
